

# Maine-Anjou Genotyping & Discovery Project Part 2

As you are all aware from the recent association e-mail blasts and introductory Genotyping & Discovery article in the October 2011 issue of the *Voice* magazine this very worthwhile project is underway. We need approximately 1,000 head in this research phase in order to validate marker effects. The American Maine-Anjou Association (AMAA) has been a part of previous research projects that have produced 50K genotypes for 59 bulls.
